SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Posters

Posters are ideal for presenting speculative in-progress work, late breaking results from completed work, or for giving an introduction to interesting, innovative theoretical work. Posters are intended to provide authors and participants with the ability to connect with each other and to engage in discussions about the work. Poster sizes are not specified; however, they should be at least 17" by 22". Presenters will be expected to bring 25 copies of their abstract and summary of research to poster session. Titles of abstracts for the Poster Session will appear in the conference program.

The 2009-2010 North Central Regions Review Committee is seeking proposals for **Poster Presentations** that focus on the conference theme of the North Central Regions National Black Graduate Student Association (NBGSA). The abstract submission deadline is **Wednesday, September 16, 2009**, and notification of proposal dispositions will be sent within a week of the day submitted.
